



# Nabi Nooh

('alaihiss salaam)


#01 - Inviting His People

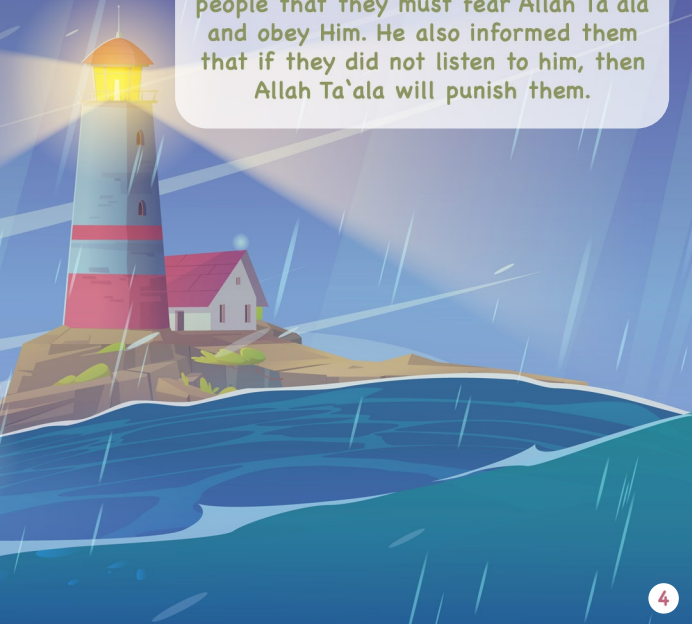
