


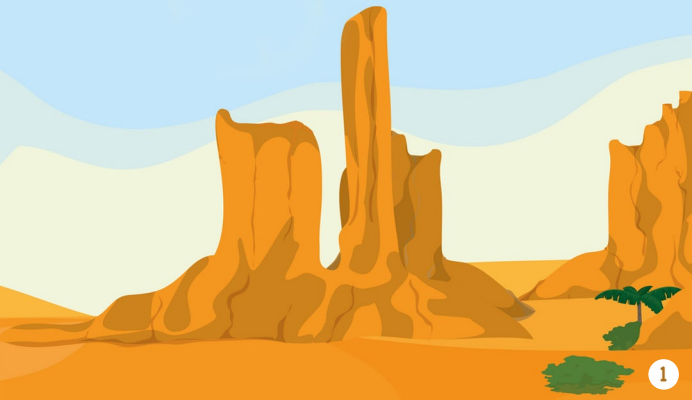
# Nabi Hood

#03 - Punishment

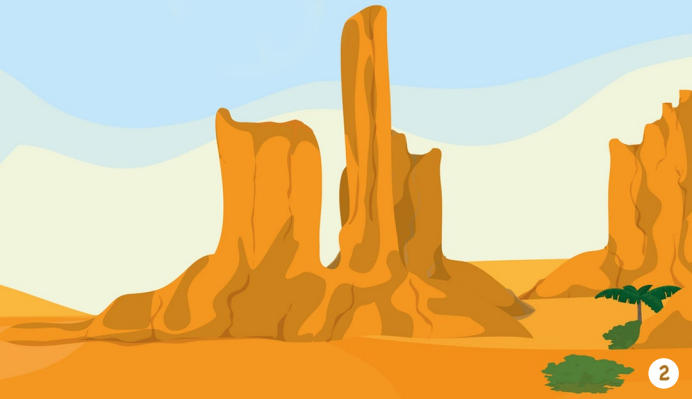

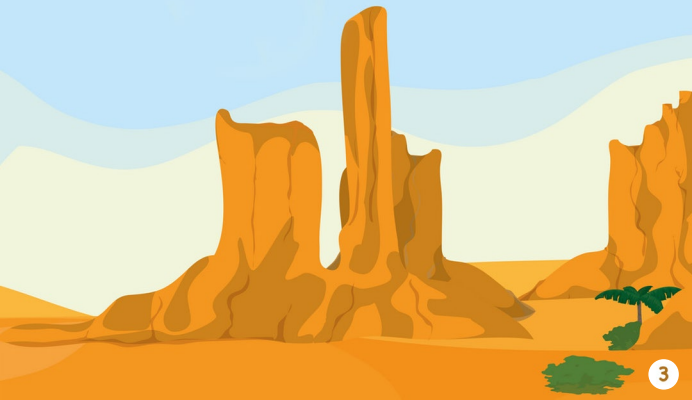



For a very long time there was no rain in the area, and the people were waiting for rain. Their animals and farms needed water. Allah Ta'ala sent clouds of punishment towards them.



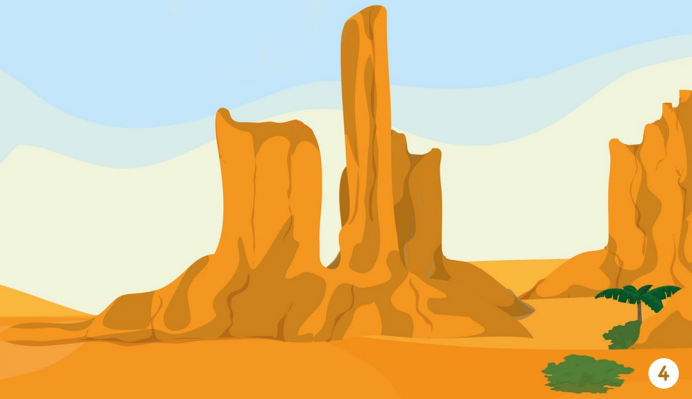

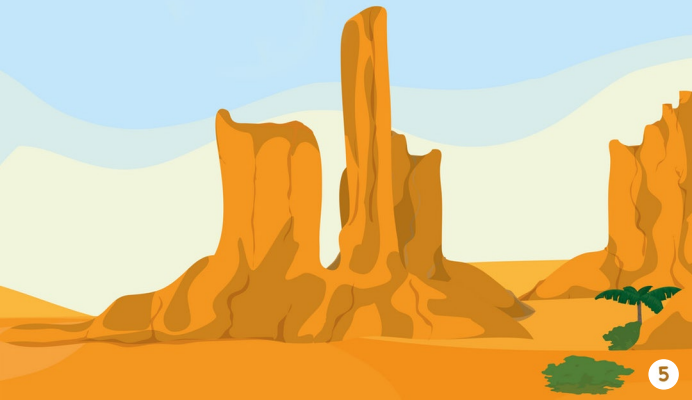
